Your programme – 3 days / 2 nights D1 – Saturday September 23, 2023 : In the footsteps of Claude Monet

Departure from your region. *Flight to Paris (optional)*. Welcome in Paris and meeting with Fabrice Roy. Then drive towards Giverny with a stop at Vétheuil where you will walk in the footsteps of the master of Impressionism from outside the house where he lived from 1878 to 1882 to the banks of the Seine where he found the pattern of nearly 200 paintings.

Continue to Giverny. Brunch lunch at the restaurant.

In the afternoon, you will visit the House of Claude Monet and its famous garden, a haven of peace where the artist lived from 1883 until his death in 1926.

Then you will head to the Museum of Impressionisms, where you will discover « **Renoir in Guernesey** ", an exhibition celebrating the 140th anniversary of the journey of Auguste Renoir in the Anglo-Normand Island. You will end the day with a visit to the **Sainte-Radegonde church** and Monet's tomb before settling at the end of the day in a 3* hotel in the Vernon region.

You will enjoy the first conference given by Fabrice Roy "Monet and Clemenceau: a friendship", followed by an aperitif.

Dinner at the restaurant. Accommodation.













D2 – Sunday, September 24, 2023 : Impressionnists Rouen and Honfleur.

Breakfast. This morning, en route to Rouen. Discovery of the capital of Normandy with its famous Cathedral then visit of the Museum of Fine Arts "In the footsteps of the impressionists"... Free lunch.

Then drive to Honfleur. Installation in your 3 * hotel in the city center. Free time for shopping and personal discoveries with the the painters who marked its history...

At the end of the day, you will attend Fabrice Roy's second conference on the theme "The Impressionists and the Seine".

Aperitif and dinner at the restaurant. Accommodation.

D3 – Monday, September 25, 2023 : Latest discoveries from Normandy

Breakfast. Visit the Eugène Boudin Museum, where you can admire an important collection of artworks by painters who have stayed in Honfleur, such as Claude Monet, Gustave Courbet, or of course Eugène Boudin. Free time at the end of the morning. Free lunch.

Departure for Paris. Flight to Nice (optional).

Lecturer, author, teacher and director, Fabrice Roy is the founder of the site <u>"Art, History and Conferences"</u> which relates the news of museums, exhibitions, painters of the 19th century and their time. Poetic, close to the theatre, sometimes surprising, his lectures draw the public into the universe of these incredible characters through the deep trace that their lives leave us as a legacy.






